

INFORMATION ON TRANSMISSION AND NON-TRANSMISSION TARIFFS ACCOMPANIED BY THE RELEVANT INFORMATION RELATED TO THEIR DERIVATION

1. COMMODITY-BASED TRANSMISSION TARIFFS REFERRED TO IN ARTICLE 4(3) — ARTICLE 30(1)(c)(i)

GAZ-SYSTEM charges commodity-based fees on physical exit points of the transmission system. The volume of regulated revenue allocated to commodity-based tariffs, in accordance with the ERO President's guidelines, is 10% of the approved regulated revenue both for high-methane gas (E) and low-methane gas (Lw).

2. NON-TRANSMISSION TARIFFS FOR NON-TRANSMISSION SERVICES REFERRED TO IN ARTICLE 4(4) — ARTICLE 30(1)(c)(ii)

GAZ-SYSTEM provides the service of odourisation of gaseous fuels. As at 30 November 2017 the GAZ-SYSTEM transmission network operates one gas-odourisation station in place, serving one final customer, under a contract expiring in August 2020. Due to the marginal nature of this service, the regulated revenue includes revenue from non-transmission services on the level achieved in the preceding year, i.e. **PLN 12,0 thousand**.

3. REFERENCE PRICES AND OTHER PRICES APPLICABLE AT POINTS OTHER THAN THOSE REFERRED TO IN ARTICLE 29.

The table presents the rates of capacity-based and commodity-based transmission rates for all points of the GAZ-SYSTEM transmission system, Article 30(1)(c)(iii).
