

Instructions for filling in the PP, PZ and PP/PZ applications

In order to avoid formal and legal deficiencies or misinterpretation of the values stated in the applications:

- The Applicant submitting an application for the execution of PP (capacity allocation) or PZ (transmission ability allocation) or PP/PZ should:
 - With respect to PZ, in addition to the general information (the heading), fill in exclusively the columns concerning:
 - name of the entry/exit point,
 - entry/exit point ID, and
 - starting and ending date of the service.
 - With respect to PP, in addition to the above information, the requested PP value should be specified for each entry/exit point.
 - The expected annual quantities of gaseous fuel to be transported should be indicated.
- The Applicant that already has executed a PP or PP/PZ (i.e. is a Network User), filling in another application for PP or PZ or a revision of PP or PZ or PP/PZ should:
 - state the value of incremental capacity by which it would like to adjust the current reserved capacity with respect to a specific entry/exit point (in case of an application for a reduction of capacity according to the TNC, the value of adjustment should be preceded with the “-” (minus) sign)
 - state the value of incremental quantities of gaseous fuel to be transported, by which it would like to adjust the current declared quantities (in case of an application for a reduction of quantities, the value of adjustment should be preceded with the “-” (minus) sign)
 - only those points where changes are to be made with respect to the currently applicable PP or PZ or PP/PZ should be included in the application.

Note: a reduction of capacity to 0 does not imply that the point in question is excluded from the contract.

IMPLEMENTING ANY CHANGES IN THE STRUCTURE OF THE APPLICATION FORM TABLE IS UNACCEPTABLE (reducing or increasing number of columns and changing of their name). Putting data in several lines concerning one entry/exit point is possible and even desirable in some cases.
