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## CONSULTATION PROCESS OF THE TARIFF MODEL PROPOSED BY GAZ-SYSTEM FOR TARIFF YEAR 2020

On 28<sup>th</sup> August 2018 GAZ-SYSTEM S.A started the process of consulting and approving the methodology for setting the reference prices for gas transmission services. The consultation aims to enable the network users to better understand the principles of transmission services tariffs calculation and changes introduced in these tariffs as well as the manner they are set.

This obligation was imposed on GAZ-SYSTEM by the decision of the President of the Energy Regulatory Office dated 16<sup>th</sup> July 2018, issued in accordance with the provisions of Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/460 of 16 March 2017 establishing a network code on harmonized transmission tariff structures for gas.

In accordance with the schedule adopted by GAZ-SYSTEM, the consultation process started at the end of August 2018 and lasted until 31st October 2018.

- The level of the discounts proposed for the underground storage facilities;
- The proposed entry – exit split;
- The possibility of implementing preferential rates at Polish-Ukrainian border.
