Applications for provision of the transmission service and for capacity/ability allocation should be submitted via the IES

INFORMATION EXCHANGE SYSTEM

According to the provisions of the TNC TGPS, the applications for transmission contract are submitted via the IES after registering in the IES.

As a result of the above, the entity applying for the execution of a transmission contract (Applicant) shall submit together with the application for transmission contract, the scans or copies thereof authenticated by individuals authorized to represent the entity, or a legal counsel or attorney:

1. documents confirming the legal status of the activity carried out by the entity, including specifically a confirmation of entry in the Central Registration and Information on Business (CEIDG) or a current extract from the National Court Register (KRS) or a computer printout of an information on the entry to the KRS, and in case of an Applicant without a registered office in the territory of the Republic of Poland, a current, issued not earlier than three months before the date of submission of the application for a Transmission Contract, extract from the relevant commercial register obtained in accordance with the principles specified in the regulations of the country where the Applicant has its registered office,
2. power of attorney or other documents confirming the right of the individuals who represent the Applicant to incur obligations on its behalf, unless such right can be inferred from the content of the document referred to in point 1,
3. certificate of tax identification number for the purposes of the tax on goods and services (VAT) for the Applicants based in the European Union Member States, unless this information can be inferred from the content of the document referred to in point 1,
4. the Applicants having their registered office in the territory of the Republic of Poland shall also present a certificate of REGON statistical number, unless this information can be inferred from the content of the document referred to in point 1,
5. the Applicants carrying out an activity in the territory of the Republic of Poland shall present a licence promise, copy of the licence or a declaration signed by persons authorised to represent the Applicant that the activities carried out by the entity do not require a licence, as provided for by the Energy Law. OSGT provides the President of the ERO with information on the submission of the above declaration by a given entity,
6. power of attorney for the person authorized to represent the Applicant in the course of the procedure of the conclusion of the capacity allocation or capacity allocation through SWI. **Submitting of the above-mentioned power of attorney is necessary to conclude an allocation of capacity (PP) and ability (PZ). Model powers of attorney to register and perform activities in IES are available in the IES tab in the Customer zone.**
7. the Applicant intending to participate in the process of allocation of available capacity through an auction shall submit the power of attorney for the person who will represent the Applicant during the auction on the Auction Platform or other online platform indicated by the OSGT, in accordance with the form published on the OSGT website.
8. an Applicant without a registered office on the territory of the Republic of Poland shall also present, together with the application for a Transmission Contract, the sworn Polish translations of the documents referred in points 1-7, which are not executed in the Polish language.
