Paweł Jakubowski: New President of the Management Board of POLSKIE LNG S.A.

The General Meeting of Shareholders of Polskie LNG S.A. appointed the President of the Management Board. Paweł Jakubowski will take office on 13 March 2018.

Paweł Jakubowski has formerly acted as Managing Director of Polskie LNG.



Paweł Jakubowski has worked in energy sector since 2007 when he started his career in the Ministry of Economy in charge of key gas supply diversification projects in Poland (e.g. LNG Terminal in winouj cie, Norwegian Shelf gas deliveries).

From November 2007 to January 2009, Mr. Jakubowski worked in Research and Development Division at PGNiG S.A.

In 2009, Paweł Jakubowski joined TSO GAZ-SYSTEM S.A. where he has been directly involved in the development of Company's long-term strategy and owner's supervision over the subsidiary - Polskie LNG S.A. He was also in charge of the development and implementation of the construction project of underground natural gas storage facilities.

Since January 2016, acting as Development Division Director at GAZ-SYSTEM, Mr. Jakubowski supervised the development and implementation of the Company's long-term investment plan in Polish gas infrastructure, including the realisation of the North-South Corridor concept through the expansion of the LNG Terminal in winouj cie and the development of the Baltic Pipe project, as well as the expansion of cross-border interconnectors with Lithuania, Slovakia, the Czech Republic and Ukraine.

As the Director of the Development Division, he also supervised the activities related with the European regulatory framework in natural gas sector, international cooperation and business development of LNG services.

Since June 2017, Mr. Jakubowski serves on the ENTSOG Board - association of natural gas transmission systems operators in the European Union Member States.

Paweł Jakubowski has graduated from Warsaw University of Technology and Warsaw School of Economics.

As of March 13th 2018 the Management Board of Polskie LNG consist of two members. Bartłomiej Słoma remains in the position of vice-president.

Polskie LNG S.A. Company was founded to manage the construction of the liquefied natural gas terminal in winouj cie and its further operation and expansion.

GAZ-SYSTEM is a strategic company for the Polish economy. It is responsible for the transmission of natural gas, manages the most important gas pipelines in Poland and owns the President Lech Kaczyński LNG Terminal in winouj cie.

As part of the 2015-2025 investment programme, GAZ-SYSTEM is constructing over 2000 km of new gas pipelines in the western, southern and eastern parts of Poland. Over a dozen new gas pipelines are under construction within the North-South Gas Corridor and the compressor station in K dzierzyn Ko le, as well as interconnections with Lithuania and Slovakia. Onshore gas pipelines are planned to connect the planned FSRU floating terminal in the Gulf of Gdansk with the national transmission system. The LNG Terminal in winouj cie is also being extended, as a result of which the regasification capacity of this facility will be increased by more than a half.

The company is also implementing one of the most important infrastructural projects in the country - the Baltic Pipe project which consists in the construction of a two-way offshore gas pipeline connecting Poland and Denmark, expansion of the local transmission network and three gas compressor stations.
